Applications on plain paper of Legal Size (8.5" X 14") either neatly hand-written or typed are invited from eligible Indian citizens who fulfill the following and other eligibility conditions as on the date of this advertisement for filling up **four (O4) posts of Translator** (for translating judgments from English to Bengali) on purely contractual basis with consolidated pay of Rs. 50,000/- per month.

Essential Qualifications :-

- 1. The candidate shall be a Law Graduate (LL.B.) of any UGC recognized university in India securing minimum 50% marks on the aggregate.
- 2. The candidate should also have passed in Class 10th & 12th standard from any recognized Board/Council with Bengali as one of the vernacular languages and English as one of the subjects.

Desirable Qualifications :-

The candidate should have computer knowledge including ability of typing.

Age Requirement :-

The candidates applying for the post shall not exceed 65 years and he/she will be at least 25 years on the date of advertisement.

Mode of Selection :-

The selection process shall consist of:

Phase-I: Written Test (test of language with ability to translate from English to Bengali) (**20** marks),

Phase-II: Computer proficiency test (10 marks) and Interview/Viva-voce (10 marks).

Total marks of the said tests & interview/viva-voce will be fifty (**40** marks). The Written Examination shall be based on English Grammar, Precis Writing, Paraphrasing, Translation and Legal Language. The candidate must secure minimum qualifying marks of 50% marks (i.e. 20 marks) in total and 40% on average in each of the said three tests (i.e. Interview – 04 marks, Test of language – 08 marks and Test of Computer – 04 marks) for final selection in the merit list.

<u>Fees :-</u>

Each application must be accompanied by application fees of **Rs. 600/-** (Rupees Six Hundred only) by Indian Postal Order, which must be purchased on a date after publication of advertisement and drawn in favour of the <u>Registrar General, High</u> <u>Court, Calcutta and payable at G.P.O. at Kolkata.</u>
