2. Candidates interested in admission for PG programmes at Central University of Karnataka have to **mandatorily register** in the *CUK-SAMARTH portal* {https://cukcuet.samarth.edu.in/pg/} displayed on the CUK website.

Only the candidates who have applied to CUET (PG) - 2025 and qualified in CUET (PG) - 2025 or GATE-2025 in appropriate subjects are eligible for registration (for more details about the eligibility for admissions to different programmes see prospectus published on the CUK website www.cuk.ac.in).

All candidates must pay the non-refundable registration fee as per the following:

- Admissions for CUK will be done only through the CUK portal (i.e., online mode only)
- Fee payment will be only through the CUK portal (online payment)
- The University will not be held responsible for any delay on the part of the candidates
- The University shall not be responsible for technical glitches or delay, if any, in payment of the fee.
- 5. For MBA programme, the candidates will be called for group discussion and personal interaction based on their merit in the entrance test (CUET-2025). The final merit for admission will be determined on the basis of marks obtained in the entrance test and Group Discussion & Personal Interaction, with 50% weightage to the entrance test and 50% to Group Discussion & personal interaction.
- 6. For M. Tech courses, 50% seats will be filled based on CUET and remaining 50% with GATE score. However, candidates who have qualified GATE 2025 have to register for CUET (PG) 2025 for being considered for admission. In case of non-

availability of GATE students, the same will be filled with CUET candidates.

- 7. The candidates applying under the reserved categories shall submit valid category certificates (SC/ST/OBC Non-Creamy Layer Certificate/ EWS) issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format at the time of registration and produce the same in original for verification at the time of admission. The candidates are advised to visit the website for the concerned certificate format.
- 8. All the prospective candidates are advised to keep ready with good quality scanned copy (JPG/ PDF format, size not exceeding 500kb for each document) of the following documents (as applicable) for uploading during online registration process.
 - Passport size Digital Photograph
 - Secondary School (10th standard) Marks Sheet
 - Senior Secondary School/PUC-II (12th standard) Marks Sheet or equivalent.
 - Valid Certificate for Date of Birth
 - Migration Certificate from last attended Board, if available
 - School Leaving Certificate/Transfer Certificate/, if available
 - Caste Certificates (ST/SC/OBC-NCL), EWS Certificates, if applicable, issued from the competent authority in GOI format.
 - Self-Declaration Form for those applying under OBC-NCL category, if applicable.
 - PWD/PH Certificate for those applying under the differently-abled category, if applicable (issued from the competent authority in GOI format).
 - Certificate of Kashmiri Migrant & Kashmiri Pandits / Kashmiri Hindu Families (Non-migrants) for those applying under the Kashmiri Migrant quota, if applicable (issued from the competent authority in GOI format).
 - Certificate(s) as a proof of Ward of Defence Category, if applicable
 - Certificate(s) of representing International, National or State level events in any sports / game for those applying under sports quota, if applicable
 - All the relevant Certificate(s) related to NCC/NSS Category, if applicable
 - Kalyana Karnataka Region (371J) Certificate, if applicable
 - Undertaking form in the case of non-submission of any required Certificates, if applicable
 - Free-ship card for SC/ST candidates from free-ship sanctioning agencies, if applicable.
- 9. Ensuring the eligibility before applying to a particular programme will be the sole responsibility of the candidate. Please read the eligibility criteria and other requirements before submitting the registration form. Submission of the online registration form is mandatory for admission to the PG programmes.
